



Northern Colorado Active 20/30 Grant Application Guidelines

Mission: Improving the quality of life for disadvantaged children in Northern Colorado.

In an effort to streamline our charity review process, NOCO 20/30 has established general requirements to which charitable organizations must conform in order to qualify as an applicant for funding and have their application reviewed by our Charity Review Committee.

General Requirements:

- Must be a nonprofit 501(c)(3) organization with a minimum of 3 years history of service (please provide copy of 501c3 exemption letter)
- Primary focus of organization must be disadvantaged youth
- Organization benefits children in Larimer and Weld County
- Financially sound organization

NOCO 20/30 Provides Grants for:

- Charitable children's organizations
- General operating support, capital/equipment purchases, technical assistance and program support
- Specific programs geared toward improving the lives of children

NOCO 20/30 Does Not Currently Provide for:

- Organizations not qualified for tax exempt status under IRS 501(c)(3)
- Individuals or families directly
- Multi-year requests
- Grants to re-granting organizations
- Sponsorship of special events
